To assist in achieving the necessary credits for Mastership in the Academy of General Dentsitry, you will be asked to present a documented dental procedure to the Mastership class. Your presentation, on Microsoft Powerpoint, must include the following to be accepted:

- 1. Title; include procedure(s) illustrated
- 2. Your name
- 3. AGD Subject Code
- 4. Case Statistics; i.e. Patient gender, age, health history, allergies, dental overview, etc
- 5. Pre-treatment photographs; should provide view of proposed treatment area
- 6. Pre-Treatment radiographs; should include topics area
- 7. Treatment Planning; i.e. discuss alternate treatment options
- 8. Anticipated Results; i.e. explain end "vision"/Goals, be sure to tie in with chosen treatment
- 9. Photos of Teatment; illustrate any steps, special procedures or techniques
- 10. Post Treatment/End Results Photos
- 11. Post Treatment/ End Result Radiographs (if applicable)
- 12. Photo Release Statements for photos, signed by Patient
